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CLAT 2027 expected Cut Off How many Marks are required ???

CLAT (Common Law Admission Test) is a relative exam — your admission depends not on your absolute score but on how you rank against roughly 70,000–90,000 other candidates competing for around 2,700 seats across 24 National Law Universities (NLUs).

This guide breaks the topic into four parts: how marks convert to rank, which NLUs you can expect at different score bands, the expected cutoff trend, and the key takeaways to guide your preparation and counselling strategy.

1. CLAT 2027 Marks vs Rank Conversion

CLAT UG is scored out of **120 marks** (120 MCQs, +1 for each correct answer, -0.25 for each wrong answer). Based on the CLAT 2025 and 2026 result trends, here is the expected marks-to-rank conversion for the General category in CLAT 2027.

Note: These are approximate, trend-based ranges — not official figures. The exact rank for a given score shifts every year depending on paper difficulty, number of test-takers, and how tightly candidates are clustered around a score. In recent cycles, mid-range scores (75–85) have seen sharper rank compression than the very top of the merit list, meaning even a 1-mark difference can shift your rank by several hundred places.

2. CLAT 2027 – Marks vs Ranks vs Expected Colleges

Once you have an expected rank range, the next step is matching it to realistic NLU options. The table below maps score bands to rank bands and the NLUs typically available at that level for the **General category**.

3. CLAT 2027 Expected Cutoff

Cutoffs are set independently by each NLU during counselling and shift across the five allotment rounds. Based on the CLAT 2025 and 2026 closing trends (General category, final round), here is the expected cutoff pattern for the top NLUs in 2027:

Key drivers behind these numbers:

- **Paper difficulty:** If paper easy...then it pushes the entire distribution up and compresses ranks near the top; a tougher paper spreads scores out.
- **Number of test-takers:** With 70,000+ candidates typically appearing, competition density keeps rising year on year.
- **Category and domicile quotas:** Reserved-category and home-state cutoffs run several thousand ranks lower than the General, open-category cutoff at the same NLU.
- **Counselling rounds:** Cutoffs usually loosen after Round 1 as candidates freeze, float, or exit seats — so a rank that looks "out of reach" in Round 1 can open up by Round 3 or later.

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4. Key Takeaways from CLAT 2027 Marks vs Rank

- **Rank matters more than marks.** CLAT has no fixed pass/fail cutoff — your admission depends entirely on your rank relative to other candidates, not the raw score itself.
- **Target 95+ marks for NLSIU/NALSAR.** The very top NLUs consistently close within the first 100–200 ranks, which realistically requires a score close to 95–100 out of 120.
- **80–90 marks is the "safe zone" for a top-10 NLU.** Most consortium members in the top tier close somewhere in this band for the General category.
- **Small mark differences swing ranks sharply in the 75–90 range,** where thousands of candidates cluster closely together — precision in the final weeks of preparation matters more here than at the extremes.
- **Reserved categories should track category-specific ranks, not General ranks —** the same score can open very different sets of NLUs.

- **Don't panic after Round 1.** Cutoffs for many NLUs move down significantly by Round 2 and Round 3 as higher-rank holders exit for better options.
