Top NLU Ranking for CLAT 2027: A Complete Guide for Law Aspirants

The bigger challenge often comes during counselling, when candidates must decide which NLUs to prioritize in their preference list.

This guide breaks down the top NLUs ranking, based on NIRF standings, CLAT closing ranks, placements, and overall reputation, to help you make an informed choice.

Why NLU Rankings Matter

India currently has 28 National Law Universities. Of these, 27 admit students through CLAT, while NLU Delhi is the exception — it conducts its own entrance exam,

AILET. With so many institutions offering a similar five-year integrated BA LLB structure, rankings become the primary tool for differentiating between them. Rankings matter because they reflect:

- **Faculty quality and research output** – how much original scholarship and teaching excellence an institution produces
- **Placement strength** – the kind of law firms, judiciary positions, and corporate roles graduates land
- **Infrastructure** – libraries, moot court facilities, hostels, and legal databases
- **Peer group and alumni network** – the quality of your batchmates and seniors, which shapes internships and career opportunities
- **Historical reputation** – how recruiters and the legal fraternity perceive a degree from that university

The most widely referenced ranking source is the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), released by the Ministry of Education. It evaluates law schools on five parameters: Teaching, Learning & Resources; Research and Professional Practice; Graduation Outcomes; Outreach and Inclusivity; and Perception.

Top NLUs Ranking 2027 (Based on NIRF and CLAT Trends)

Here is how the top NLUs currently stack up, combining NIRF standing with CLAT counselling performance:

1. National Law School of India University (NLSIU), Bangalore

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Aspect	Details

3. NALSAR University of Law, Hyderabad

NALSAR University of Law, Hyderabad

Institute	NALSAR (National Academy of Legal Studies and Research)
Overall Ranking	Firmly in the top three among NLUs for years
Reputation	Frequently seen as the strongest CLAT-admitted alternative to NLSIU
Closing Rank (General Category)	Approximately 150–170
Areas of Special Reputation	Intellectual Property (IP) Law, Technology Law
Placement Strength	Draws some of the best corporate law firm recruiters in the country

NALSAR has remained firmly in the **top three** for years and is frequently seen as the TOP NLU for bright future

4. West Bengal National University of Juridical Sciences (WBNUJS), Kolkata

Also known as NUJS, this university has stayed in the top five NIRF rankings and is a strong CLAT choice, with closing ranks typically in the **280–330** range. **WBNUJS** is well known for human rights law and corporate law specializations, and it often reports some of the highest average placement packages among NLUs.

5. Gujarat National Law University (GNLU), Gandhinagar

GNLU has shown consistent upward movement in rankings and entered the national top five in recent NIRF cycles. It offers one of the most diverse sets of undergraduate programs among NLUs, including **BA LLB, BBA LLB, BCom LLB, BSc LLB, and BSW LLB**. Its closing rank typically hovers between **420–480**.

Preference Filling Strategy for CLAT Counselling

A common mistake CLAT aspirants make is filling only a handful of NLU preferences, hoping for a Tier 1 seat and missing out on a Tier 2 or Tier 3 option they might actually have qualified for. The general strategic advice is:

- 1. List all 27 CLAT-participating NLUs** in your preference order, even if some are far down the list. This maximizes your chances of getting a seat somewhere rather than losing eligibility altogether.
- 2. Rank by realistic expectation**, not just aspiration — cross-check your CLAT rank against historical closing ranks for each NLU.
- 3. Balance ranking with fit** — a Tier 2 NLU with strong placements in your area of interest may serve you better than a Tier 1 NLU where you'd be at the bottom of the merit list.
- 4. Watch the counselling window closely** — CLAT counselling typically opens in mid-to-late December and closes within about ten days, so preference lists need to be finalized without last-minute rushing.
